Open to any horse and any rider. Rider and owner must be BCRCHA members. Riders may show multiple horses. Follows full NCHA rules.	Open to any non-professional or amateur rider showing any horse owned by the rider or an immediate family member. One horse per rider per show. Follows full NCHA rules.	Open to any rider showing any horse that has not won more than \$25,000 in NCHA weekend classes (i.e., excludes aged events) as per NCHA eligibility. Riders may show multiple horses. Follows full NCHA rules.	Open to any amateur rider with NCHA earnings of not more than \$15,000. Rider may show one horse per show and horse must be owned by rider or immediate family member. Follows full NCHA rules.	Open to ANY rider with NCHA earnings of not more than \$2,000. Rider may show only one horse per show but may show any horse. Follows full NCHA rules.
Intended for but not restricted to trainers and very experienced riders showing finished cutting horses.	Intended for but not restricted to experienced non-pro or amateur riders showing finished cutting horses that they or their family own.	Intended for but not restricted to trainers and very experienced riders showing finished cutting horses with limited earnings.	Intended for intermediate or novice amateur riders typically showing finished cutting horses.	Intended for novice riders showing advanced or finished cutting horses.

Open to any rider that has not reached their 18 th birthday by January 1 st of the current year showing any horse. One horse per rider per show and helmets must be worn. Can be ridden one or two handed with no penalties for stopping on ends or reining through the turn.	Open to any rider showing any derby horse (regardless of earnings) or any other horse with NCHA earnings of up to \$1,000. Can be ridden one or two handed (cannot switch) and horse can be stopped on the ends. Rider can show multiple horses.	Open to any non-pro or amateur rider showing any derby horse (regardless of earnings) or any other horse with NCHA earnings of up to \$1,000. Horse must be owned by the rider or immediate family member. Must be ridden one-handed but can be stopped on the ends. Rider can show multiple horses.	Open to any amateur rider with earnings of less than \$500 showing any horse owned by the rider or immediate family member with earnings of less than \$500. May be ridden one or two handed and can switch back and forth without penalty. Horse can be stopped on the ends without penalty.	Open to any non-professional or amateur rider with NCHA earnings not exceeding \$500. One horse per rider per show. May be ridden one or two handed and can switch back and forth without penalty. Horse can be stopped on the ends without penalty.
Intended for youth members.	Intended for any open rider (typically trainers) showing four year olds or other novice cutting horses.	Intended for non-pro or amateur riders showing four year olds or other novice cutting horses.	Intended for novice or beginner riders showing novice or beginner horses.	Intended for novice or beginner riders showing any horse.
