<u>CUTTING EARNINGS</u>: The BCRCHA will recognize all NCHA eligible week-end earnings (not including LAE) as of Jan 1 each year. The exception being the 2000 LR, the BCRCHA will follow the NCHA rule where all lifetime cutting earnings, in all cutting competitions count towards eligibility. This includes, but is not limited to, NCHA, Aged Events as well as non-sanctioned events. Please consider this when choosing which class you are eligible to enter.

<u>JUDGING</u>: NCHA approved tack only unless noted otherwise. Horses may be shown in snaffle bits, bosals and romals in noted classes. All classes will be judged on NCHA Scorecards.
