

<p>Open FRESH</p> <p>Open to any horse and rider. Rider and owner must be BCRCHA members. Riders may show multiple horses.</p> <p>*Intended for but not restricted to trainers and very experienced riders showing finished cutting horses</p>	<p>Non-Pro FRESH</p> <p>Open to any Non-Pro or Amateur rider. Rider may show two horses per show and horses must be owned by rider or immediate family member.</p> <p>*Intended for but not restricted to experienced Non-Pro or Amateur riders showing finished cutting horses</p>	<p>10K Novice Horse FRESH</p> <p>Open to any rider, showing any horse with cutting earnings that do not exceed \$10,000. Riders may show multiple horses.</p> <p>*Intended for but not restricted to trainers and very experienced riders showing finished cutting horses with limited earnings</p>	<p>15K Amateur FRESH</p> <p>Open to any Amateur* rider with cutting earnings that do not exceed \$15,000. Riders may show one horse per show and the horse must be owned by the rider or immediate family member.</p> <p>*Intended for intermediate or novice amateur riders typically showing finished cutting horses</p>
<p>\$2,000 Limited Rider USED</p> <p>Open to any rider with cutting earnings that do not exceed \$2000. Must be ridden one handed. Riders can show any horse, you do not have to own it. Riders may show only one horse per show. ALL cutting earnings will be counted in determining eligibility.</p> <p>*Intended for novice riders showing advanced or finished cutting horses</p>	<p>\$1,000 Novice Horse Open FRESH</p> <p>Open to ANY rider, showing any horse with cutting earnings that do not exceed \$1,000. May be ridden one or two handed, riders permitted to switch and stop on ends. Riders can show multiple horses. May be shown with romal reins or in a bosal.</p> <p>*Intended for riders showing novice cutting or cow horses</p>	<p>\$1,000 Novice Horse Non Pro FRESH</p> <p>Open to any Non-Pro rider, showing any horse with cutting earnings that do not exceed \$1,000. May be ridden one or two handed, riders permitted to switch and stop on ends Riders can show multiple horses but must own the horse. May be shown with romal reins or in a bosal.</p> <p>*Intended for Non Pro riders showing novice cutting or cow horse</p>	<p>\$500 Ranch Horse USED</p> <p>Open to any rider showing any horse with cutting earnings that do not exceed \$500. Can be ridden one or two handed, switching permitted and horse can be stopped on the ends. Riders can show multiple horses. May be shown with romal reins or in a bosal.</p> <p>*Intended for any rider showing novice cutting or cow horses</p>
<p>\$500 Limited Rider USED</p> <p>Open to any rider with cutting earnings that do not exceed \$500. Can be ridden one or two handed, switching permitted and horses can be stopped on the ends. Riders can show any horse, you do not have to own it. May be shown with romal reins or in a bosal. Rider must not have won class in a prior year.</p> <p>*Intended for novice riders showing any horse</p>	<p>Youth USED</p> <p>Open to any rider that has not reached their 18th birthday by January 1st of the current year showing any horse. HELMETS MUST BE WORN. Can be ridden one or two handed (cannot switch) and may stop on the ends. One horse per rider per show.</p> <p>* Intended for youth riders</p>	<p>Blue indicates an OPEN Rider Class Green indicates a NON-PRO Rider Class</p>	



CUTTING EARNINGS: The BCRCHA will recognize all NCHA eligible week-end earnings (not including LAE) as of Jan 1 each year. The exception being the 2000 LR, the BCRCHA will follow the NCHA rule where all lifetime cutting earnings, in all cutting competitions count towards eligibility. This includes, but is not limited to, NCHA, Aged Events as well as non-sanctioned events. Please consider this when choosing which class you are eligible to enter.

JUDGING: NCHA approved tack only unless noted otherwise. Horses may be shown in snaffle bits, bosals and romals in noted classes. All classes will be judged on NCHA Scorecards.

CATTLE: Class definitions indicate FRESH or USED Cattle. In the event the BCRCHA cannot secure enough FRESH, the \$1,000 NH Classes could be used. Riders will be notified prior to show day.
